AGENDA ITEM #5 OLD BUSINESS

Action Items - reports

Item 1: Electronic Plans Distribution. This item is in conjunction with Item 2 below.

Item 2: Seals; Guideline Document. This Item will require statute revisions, a draft of was given to Board members for review. A draft document entitled "Guidelines for Certifying, Sealing, Signing, and Dating Documents Prepared by Licensed Technical Professionals in South Dakota" has been developed, which the board members are currently reviewing. A deadline for feedback on this draft document was set for the July board meeting.

Item 3: Discipline Questions on Application Not Clear. This item is complete and form updates have been loaded on the website.

Item 4: Clarification of Intent That a Person Can Only be in Responsible Charge of One Office. A statute revision would be necessary for completion of this item. A draft of statute revisions is currently being written.

Item 5: All licensees must be linked to a CoA to practice. This will require a statute revision and a draft is being developed.

Item 6: Cross Practice in Construction Administration. A draft statute revision has been prepared and is being reviewed by Board members.

Item 7: Fire Protection Engineer Requirement. A meeting needs to be set up to include the Fire Marshall, fire sprinkler systems installers, and Rapid City Building Officials to discuss this issue and determine if there are any rules revisions needed regarding this requirement. The Board discussed re-delegating this item to another board member, as Shafai is no longer a board member. Chairman Neugebauer will contact Shafai regarding how best to handle this transition.

Item 8: Building Officials Guide. The Board is still working on this item. A draft is being reviewed. The Board is also looking at an example Building Officials Guide developed by NCARB.

Item 9: Rewrite Petroleum Release Exam. The Board is still working on this item.

Item 10: Rewrite FS and PS Exam Applications. Form updates are on the website.

Item 11: Rewrite FE and PE exam Applications. Form updates are on the website.

Item 12: Install Wi-Fi connection in the Boardroom. This item is pending the move to the new Board offices.

Item 13: Review Experience requirements between Assessor and Remediator. This is a work in progress and requires coordination with the state to try to come up with a better description of the differences between these two professions. Language in Administrative Rules needs to be revised to clarify the roles between these two professions.

Item 14: Reduction in available funds. This item will be affected by the cost of moving the Board office to the new location.

Website review and update

Conversion from classic asp to .net - BPro

The Board discussed the progress of the conversion and noted that this update is currently in progress. The BPro contract for completing the conversion had been extended to May 31 and the board website has been inoperable for a few days to make the necessary changes and complete the conversion.

Review of forms

The forms review is complete and the updated forms are on the website.

Pearson VUE test site in Rapid City

The Board discussed the status of the Pearson VUE test site in Rapid City. Dr. Gunn at SDSM&T is in charge of the project of creating a Pearson VUE select test site here in Rapid City on the SDSM&T campus. The test site is currently up and running.

Office Location Selected

The site for the new Board offices has been selected and a lease is signed. Modifications to the existing space are being made prior to the move in August.

AGENDA ITEM #6 NEW BUSINESS

Welcome to new Board members -

Michael Albertson, PE

John S. (Steve) Peters, LS

Chairman Neugebauer introduced the new board members Michael Albertson, PE and John S. Peters, LS. The Board extended a warm welcome to its new board members.

Board Members reappointed, Dennis Micko & Jeffrey Nelson

The Board congratulated Dennis Micko and Jeffrey Nelson on their reappointment to the Board.

NCARB - Transition to ARE 5.0

The Board discussed the NCARB transition from ARE 4.0 to ARE 5.0. This is a major change to the test division structure and test specifications for architectural intern examinations administered by NCARB under the Intern Development Program (IDP). This transition should not greatly affect the current process the Board uses to license Architects as we have direct registration with NCARB.

NCEES - ACCA Motion 1

The Board discussed NCEES - ACCA Motion 1. This motion is about the process of decoupling experience, education, and the PE exam in the licensure process to allow for early taking of the PE exam. Some states already allow for early testing and licensing. This major change could adversely affect the process of licensure nationwide. The Board voted against this motion at the August 2013 NCEES Annual Meeting in San Antonio, Texas. At the May 2014 NCEES Central/Western Zone Meeting in Lincoln, Nebraska, Chairman Neugebauer, Secretary Micko, and Executive Director Humphreys handed out a white paper entitled, "Points of Concern over Early PE Testing", which was developed by the Board and lists the concerns and possible ramifications of modifying model law as proposed by passing ACCA Motion 1. This motion would allow students to take the PE exam either before or shortly after graduating with a Bachelors of Science in Engineering. The PE exam was originally designed to be practice based and South Dakota's current Statutes and Rules require 4 years of experience before taking the exam. In some jurisdictions, early PE exam takers may even be required to retake the PE exam after gaining the 4 years of experience. This experience requirement allows the engineering intern to gain adequate experience to prepare them for the PE exam and subsequent licensure.

This proposal was voted on at the 2013 NCEES Annual meeting in San Antonio, with 42 jurisdictions voting for the proposal and 24 jurisdictions voting against it. Since then, the NCEES UPLG committee to determine how it could be incorporated into Model Law studied this proposal. This proposed revision to Model Law will be voted on at the 2014 NCEES Annual meeting in Seattle. In the future, the PS exam may also be proposed to allow for taking this exam prior to completing the education and experience required for licensure.

In the opinion of the Board, this proposal if it passes could negatively affect the licensure process. If taken to court, the courts could determine that if you can take the Practice of Engineering Exam without any practical experience, then all you need to practice engineering is an engineering degree and the PE exam. Therefore, the Board agreed that it is important to circulate the Board's concerns to all the jurisdictions so that these concerns can be taken into consideration during the vote at the 2014 NCEES Annual meeting in Seattle. This is an important vote that will decide whether Model Law will be revised as proposed and the Board feels that the concerns outlined in the above mentioned white paper should be taken into consideration and mitigated prior to passing and implementing such a change in Model Law.

Travel Reimbursement - New Rules

New state travel reimbursement rules were briefly discussed.

NCEES Credential Evaluation Question

An applicant listed a Master of Science degree from Warren National University on his application. Warren National University is a diploma mill and the applicant cannot get transcripts from this institution. This applicant also has a Bachelor of Science in Geology, which is not a qualifying degree. The Board recommends the applicant have an NCEES Credentials Evaluation done and mitigate any deficiencies prior to re-applying for licensure.
