

SOUTH DAKOTA COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

December 31, 2015

CALL MEETING TO ORDER

A conference call emergency meeting of the Cosmetology Commission was called to order by President Tammy Ugofsky on Thursday, December 31, 2015 at 2:05 pm. The meeting was held via conference call.

1. ROLL CALL

Attendance was taken by Secretary-Treasurer Laurie Brandner, with the following members present: President Tammy Ugofsky, Lori Berreth, Laurie Brandner, Crystal Carlson, and Lori Little. Staff present: Executive Director Kate Boyd and Attorney Aaron Arnold. Also present was cosmetology inspector Mary Rasmussen and Angela Kennecke of KELO News.

2. DN NAIL SALON - Review Inspection Violations & Consider Possible Action

The purpose of this emergency meeting was to review the inspection report of DN Nails Salon and consider possible action.

Cosmetology Inspector Mary Rasmussen informed the Commission that she and Inspector Karen Dossett went into DN Nails Salon earlier in the day to inspect the salon. The salon failed its inspection due to: (1) water standing in the drains of all four pedicure spas, (2) used buffers that had not been properly disposed of, (3) disinfectant not labeled, (4) used drill bits were in the drawer with sanding bits, (5) soiled items that were not properly stored, (6) emery boards that had been used and not thrown away. While the inspectors were there, water was added to the pedicure spas, they were run and drained, but the water kept coming back up into the drains.

This emergency meeting had been called due to the health risk of the used water in the drains back-flowing into the fresh water and contaminating the water during each pedicure.

IT WAS MOVED BY LAURIE BRANDNER, SECONDED BY CRYSTAL CARLSON, TO ORDER AN EMERGENCY SUSPENSION, PURSUANT TO SDCL 1-26-29, OF SALON LICENSE NS-03911-2016, D N NAILS SALON, 2720 W 12TH ST STE 300, SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA UNTIL: (1) THE COMMISSION RECEIVES A WRITTEN REPORT FROM A LICENSED PLUMBER STATING THAT THE DRAIN ISSUES IN THE PEDICURE SPAS HAVE BEEN CORRECTED AND (2) THE SALON PASSES A NEW INSPECTION PERFORMED BY THE COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION INSPECTOR. THE MOTION PREVAILED UNANIMOUSLY ON A ROLL CALL VOTE WITH LORI BERRETH, LAURIE BRANDNER, CRYSTAL CARLSON, LORI LITTLE AND TAMMY UGOFSKY VOTING AYE.

ADJOURN

IT WAS MOVED BY LAURIE BRANDNER, SECONDED BY LORI BERRETH, TO ADJOURN. THE MOTION PREVAILED UNANIMOUSLY ON A ROLL CALL VOTE WITH LORI BERRETH, LAURIE BRANDNER, CRYSTAL CARLSON, LORI LITTLE AND TAMMY UGOFSKY VOTING AYE.
