SOUTH DAKOTA COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION SKIN CARE EQUIPMENT

It is **<u>recommended</u>** that before purchasing mechanical or electrical skin care equipment look for the following requirements:

- 1. Manufacturer FDA registered (FDA registration number as a Class one or Class Two device)
- 2. Each piece of equipment FDA registered (Intended Use Statement)
- 3. UL or CSA certification <u>www.ul.com</u> (CSA is Canadian)
- 4. ISO certified manufacturer <u>www.iso.org</u>
- 5. Manufacturer's Product Liability Insurance

Equipment backed by all five of these items will ensure cosmetology and esthetic practices with appropriate, quality equipment.

Prohibited equipment and procedures. The following equipment and procedures are prohibited by licensees of the South Dakota Cosmetology Commission: (1) Demaplane procedures, demabrasion procedures, ultrasound equipment, blades, knives, and any tools, except for lancets used specifically for extraction of impurities, that invade the skin or living cells; and (2) any procedure in which human tissue is cut or altered by mechanical or energy form, including electrical or laser energy or ionizing radiation. ARSD 20:42:04:03.

Continuing Education is required before a licensee can practice microdermabrasion and electric files. ARSD 20:42:08.
