Renewal

All Licenses will expire June 30, 2016. Renewal forms received after June 30, 2016 will require a re-instatement fee of \$50 prior to renewing. Renewal forms received after June 30, 2017 will require examination prior to renewal.

16 hours of Continuing Education with a minimum of 8 hours of Code is required to renew your license. Those exempt from the continuing education requirement are new reciprocal licenses and apprentices who obtained their license after June 30, 2015. If you've been deployed during this time, and returned home before July 1, 2015, you will be required to obtain continuing education hours. A maximum of 8 hours may be attained through online classes per biennial renewal

SDCL 25-7A-56 states, "No state agency or board may issue or renew the professional, sporting, or recreational license, registration, certification, or permit of an applicant after receiving notice from the DSS that the applicant had support arrearages in the sum of \$1,000 or more, unless the applicant first makes satisfactory arrangements with the DSS..."

Call for Inspections

- All inspections including rough-in, final, corrections and swimming pool bonding require a 72 hour notice
- A "No Rough-In" letter will be delivered to owners for any installation which required a rough-in and didn't receive one

Notes from the Commission

- All electrical installations with a calculated inspection fee of \$10 or greater requires a wiring permit and minimum electrical inspection fee
- Please energize only listed equipment. Contact the Commission prior to energizing if the equipment is not listed
