Dear Mr. Perry,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a non-resident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for a non-resident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on August 4, 2014. You disclosed in your application that you have been convicted or charged with a misdemeanor. The application required that you provide a detailed written statement explaining the circumstances of the misdemeanor and copies of any official documents. This information was never provided to the Division. You also failed to respond to a Division email dated October 6, 2014, which requested that you provide a detailed explanation of the misdemeanor. Furthermore, you failed to disclose the misdemeanor in your 2011 South Dakota license application.

Based on the above information, your application is denied pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-167(1), (2), (6) and (8) for incompleteness, violating any insurance law, for having been convicted of a felony, and for demonstrating incompetence or untrustworthiness.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
