RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Ms. Cook Bey,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on September 10, 2019. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the question regarding misdemeanor convictions. You failed to provide the required documentation regarding your criminal history with your application.

Due to the above, the Division wrote to you via email on September 11, 2019 to request a written explanation regarding why the required documentation was not provided, a written statement explaining the circumstances of each incident, a copy of the charging document, and a copy of the official document demonstrating the resolution of the charges or final judgment. Having failed to receive a response from you, the Division wrote to you via regular mail and email on September 26, 2019 to request the same information and documentation. Having failed to receive a response from you, the Division wrote to you via certified mail, regular mail, and email on October 29, 2019 requesting a response. To date, the Division has not received a response.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL §§ 58-30-167(1) and (2) for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application and for violating the insurance laws or rules of the State of South Dakota.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
