RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Harris,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on September 17, 2020. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the questions concerning misdemeanor convictions. However, the required documentation was not provided with your application.

Due to the above, the Division wrote to you on September 18, 2020 via email to request an explanation regarding incorrect, misleading, or incomplete information that was submitted, a written statement explaining the circumstances of each incident, a copy of the charging document, and official documentation demonstrating the resolution of the charges or any final judgment. After failing to receive a response from you, the Division wrote to you on April 26, 2021 via regular mail and email requesting the same explanations and documentation. After failing to receive a response from you, the Division wrote to you on June 9, 2021 via certified mail, regular mail, and email requesting a response from you. To this date, the Division has not received a response from you.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL 58-30-167(1) for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
