RE: Application for Insurance Producer License/Denial

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You applied for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on September 10, 2020. You answered "YES" to questions 1A, indicating that you have been charged with, convicted of, or plead guilty to a misdemeanor. You provided documentation showing that you have been charged with or convicted of the following offenses:

- 1999 Felony Possession of Cocaine, reduced to a misdemeanor in 2016
- 1999 Misdemeanor Controlled Substance;
- 1999 Misdemeanor Controlled Substance;
- 2007 Misdemeanor Controlled Substance;
- 2009 Misdemeanor, Battery on an Officer; Resisting Arrest, and Public Intoxication;
- 2013 Misdemeanor Battery; False Imprisonment; and Neglect of a child;
- 2014 Misdemeanor Corporal Injury to Spouse, Intimidating a Witness;
 Human Trafficking

Based on the above information, your application is denied because you have been determined not to be in good standing under ARSD 20:06:01:03 and for violating SDCL 58-30-167(2) violating the insurance laws or rules of South Dakota or any other state; and for violating 58-30-167(8) for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.



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Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
