Christian Beltran Canales,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as an insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") for an individual insurance producer license on December 22, 2022. You answered "yes" regarding questions about felonies and administrative actions. The Division conducted an investigation of your application, where you provided documentation showing crimes involving conspiracy and intent to distribute controlled substances. You were sentenced to 24 months' probation. Texas issued you an 18 U.S.C. § 1033 waiver, although Texas is not your resident state. You were also subject to an administrative action in the State of Florida, a license denial based on your criminal history.

Based on the above information, your application is denied under SDCL 58-30-167(2), (6), (8), and (9) for violating any insurance laws or rules, subpoena, or order of the director or of another state's insurance director, commissioner, or superintendent, for having been convicted of a felony, for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere, for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory, and for not being in good standing pursuant to ARSD 20:06:01:03 and 20:06:01:04.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
