RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Myron

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on September 20, 2023. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the question 1B concerning felony convictions. However, you failed to provide all the required documentation regarding your criminal convictions.

Due to this discrepancy, on October 16, 2023, the Division wrote to you via email and informed you that additional documentation was needed and requested a written statement regarding your convictions. You responded on November 3, 2023, and provided documentation showing that in 2019, in Case No. 84-CR-19-559, you were charged with 10 counts of misdemeanor and felony offenses. In a plea bargain, you were convicted of one felony offense for Felony Fleeing Officer; Death; Bodily Injury, and one misdemeanor offense for Driving While Impaired. The documentation also showed that you will be on probation until approximately January 5, 2028.

Based on the above information, your application is denied because you have been determined not to be in good standing under ARSD 20:06:01:03 and based upon SDCL 58-30-167 (1), (2), & (6), for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application; violating any insurance laws or rules; and having been convicted of a felony.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.
