RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on August 22, 2023. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the question 1B concerning felony. You provided records showing that you were arrested for, or found guilty of Felony Animal Cruelty. Your records also show you are currently on probation until November 2024.

Based on the above information, your application is denied because you have been determined not to be in good standing under ARSD 20:06:01:03 and based upon SDCL 58-30-167 (2),(6) for violating any insurance laws or rules and having been convicted of a felony.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.



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Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
