Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Tammen,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an insurance producer license to the Division on June 5, 2023. On the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the question concerning felony convictions and "No" to the question concerning administrative actions. You provided documentation of your felony conviction with your application. While investigating your application, it was discovered that you were the subject of an administrative action in the State of Kansas. Kansas denied your application for licensure on October 11, 2021, due to criminal record/history of filing false tax returns.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL 58-30-167(1), (2), (6), & (9) for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application; violating the insurance laws or rules of the State of South Dakota and another state; having been convicted of a felony, and having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in another state.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
