Green job publications, including a green career opportunities poster and reports on the greening of South Dakota's economy.

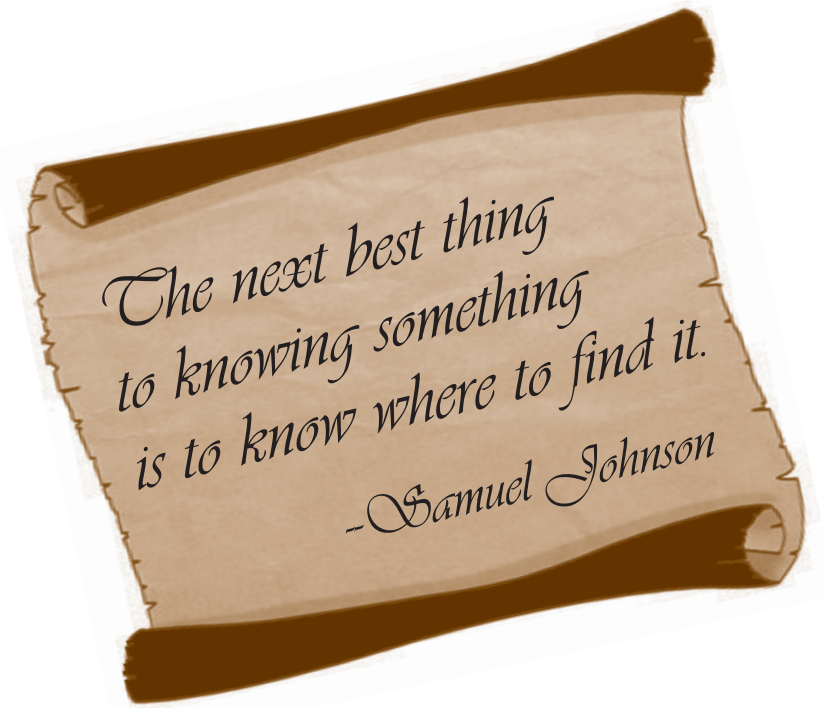
### Career InSite

The Labor Market Information Center (LMIC) is a part of the South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation. Our purpose is to collect, analyze and provide, to the public, information on the labor market of the state, such as employment levels, unemployment rates, wage and earnings data, labor supply, employment projections and business staffing patterns. Our staff possesses expertise in labor economics and analysis, primary and secondary research and public information. Among those who use our information are employers, economic development groups, public agencies, career decision makers, employment specialists, and education and training program planners.
