




Police & Sheriff's Patrol Officers


Correctional Officers & Jailers

Lifeguards, Ski Patrol & Other Recreational Protective Service Workers

Lifeguards, ski patrol and other recreational protective service workers watch recreational areas, like pools, beaches and ski slopes. They rescue people in trouble. They provide first aid. Many have CPR training. They contact emergency services if someone is badly hurt. Some also offer lessons.

Private detectives and investigators find information for people and businesses. Some investigate crimes or look for people who are missing. They might check if people told the truth about where they work. They also can be bodyguards. Sometimes they work undercover.
