Labor department offers online subscription service for workers' compensation updates

PIERRE, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Labor (SDDOL) has introduced a new method for interested parties to receive updates on the workers' compensation system. An e-lert notification is available by subscribing to the service at www.sdjobs.org.

“Our Workers' Compensation Advisory Council was looking at ways we could distribute notices more quickly,” said Secretary of Labor Pam Roberts. “A suggestion was made by Chairman Lieutenant Governor Dennis Daugaard to investigate electronic options. E-lerts was implemented, so now subscribers will receive an e-mail every time our Web site is updated or new information is posted.”

The Workers' Compensation Advisory Council was created to aid the SDDOL by reviewing the workers' compensation system's content, adequacy and effectiveness. Members also have the responsibility to make recommendations for its improvement.
