

What is the dislocated worker program?

The South Dakota Department of Labor (DOL) provides employment and training assistance to those who become unemployed by plant closures or mass layoffs. This program helps provide a smooth transition to other employment.

What services are provided?

- Placement services, such as job search assistance
- Unemployment Insurance benefits
- Labor market information
- Computer access to local, state, and national job openings
- Aptitude, basic skills and vocational interest testing
- Job counseling for guidance with vocational choices and career decisions
- Individual training programs leading to employment (Workforce Investment Act)
