Northern State University M.S. in Banking and Financial Services

- The new degree is designed to meet the workforce needs of the South Dakota banking and financial services industry.
- The University consulted with industry leaders during the development of the curriculum. Industry leaders also serve on the NSU Banking and Financial Services Advisory Board.
- The Board authorized NSU to deliver the new degree online so that bankers could complete the degree without relocating or commuting to Aberdeen.
