





Get APPROVAL to test

ATTENDING SCHOOL

Must have **one** of the following:

- Verification you will not graduate with your class because of credit deficiency from the school
- Authorization from a court services officer;
- · A court order requiring you to enter the program;
- Verification you are under the direction of the Department of Corrections; or
- Verification you are enrolled in Job Corps

RECEIVING ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION

Your parent/guardian must have **filed an <u>Alternative</u>** <u>Instruction Notification</u> with the South Dakota Department of Education (DOE).

then

COMPLETE these steps

- 1. Create GED account at GED.com
- 2. Have your parent/guardian work with the school district to develop a plan
- 3. Have the school district complete and submit DLR's **Underage GED Testing Waiver**

where to **TAKE** the tests

- A list of testing sites in the state can be found in your GED account.
- Or test from home while securely monitored by an online proctor (ged.com/take-the-ged-test-online)
- Each of the four subtests costs \$50, paid at the time of registration. Re-tests are available at a cost of \$20 each.

- 1. Create a GED account at GED.com
 - You must create your GED.com account and file DOE notification before moving to Step 2 (or your waiver will not be accepted.)
- 2. Complete DLR's <u>Underage GED Testing Waiver for</u>
 Alternative Instruction
 - Follow instructions in verification email once you have submitted the waiver.
