A public hearing will be held via conference call, on October 23, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. CT, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered

The effect of the rules will be to update references; add language to waive certain requirements; update definitions, program measurements, criteria and standards for continuing professional education; and repeal rules in regard to the South Dakota peer review program.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to update references, expand criteria to waive certain requirements, include new methods for continuing professional education, and eliminating the South Dakota peer review program.

Material sent by mail must reach the Board of Accountancy office by October 19, 2018, to be considered.

After the hearing, the board will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
