All parties and witnesses must be personally present on the Zoom Conference Call for the hearing unless otherwise authorized by the Board.

This hearing is being held pursuant to the legal authority and jurisdiction granted to the Board under South Dakota Codified Laws (SDCL) Chapters 1-26, 36-1C, and 36-20B.

The purpose of this hearing will be to determine whether Robert Bork (Licensee) violated SDCL 36-1C-8 by failing to timely respond to the formal complaint; and SDCL 36-20B-40(3) and/or (6) by failing to meet the Board's continuing professional education requirements for licensees.

Following the hearing, the Board shall issue findings of fact, conclusions of law, and a decision that may take such actions as are authorized by SDCL Chapters 1-26, 36-1C, and 36-20B, which may include, but is not limited to, issuance of an administrative fine, suspension of the license, and/or revocation of the license. Pursuant to SDCL 1-26-29.1, should this proceeding result in discipline of Licensee, the Board may assess all or part of its actual expenses for this proceeding against Licensee.

This hearing is a contested case as that term is defined in SDCL 1-26-1(2). As such, this hearing is an adversarial proceeding. You have the right to be present at the hearing and to be represented by an attorney. These and other due process rights will be forfeited if they are not exercised at the hearing. If you intend to be represented by an attorney, please have your attorney contact the undersigned with their name, address, and contact information.

If you do not appear at the scheduled time of the hearing, the matter may be dismissed, or it may be decided on the basis of evidence presented at the hearing.

If the amount in controversy exceeds \$2,500 or if a property right may be terminated, a party to the contested case may require the Board to use the Office of Hearing Examiners by giving notice of the request to the Board no later than ten days after service of this notice of hearing.

Notice of the Board's decision will be sent to Bork within 30 days after this matter is fully submitted to the Board, unless such time is extended by the Board pursuant to SDCL 1-26-30.1. The decision based on the hearing may be appealed to the Circuit Court and the South Dakota Supreme Court, as provided by law.

ARSD 20:75:04:11. Review of continuing professional education credits.

ARSD 20:75:04:15. Documentation for continuing professional education credit.

Facts that support the alleged violations of South Dakota law or rule:

- 1. Robert Bork (BORK) is licensed by the Board as a certified public accountant (CPA) and has been so licensed since October 27, 1999.
- 2. As a licensee of the Board, BORK is required to report his continuing professional education (CPE) hours to the Board in the manner required by the Board.
- 3. For the period commencing July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, BORK reported 48 CPE hours.

- 4. For the period commencing July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, BORK reported 40 CPE hours.
- 5. For the period commencing July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, BORK reported 32 CPE hours.
- On September 18, 2023, the Board office mailed a letter to BORK which stated that he was selected for a CPE audit for the three-year period commencing July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023. The letter stated that the deadline to submit documentation was October 31, 2023.
- On October 23, 2023, BORK submitted partial CPE documentation to the Board office.
- 8. On November 20, 2023, Board office staff emailed Licensee that the claimed course titled Reviewing Pass-Throughs from the SD CPA Society on November 9, 2020, for 8 CPE hours could not be verified from the SD CPA Society sign-in sheets provided to the Board. The sign-in sheet indicated that he did not attend the course and credit was not given. Board staff asked for any additional documentation or additional courses to claim be submitted by November 30, 2023.
- On November 20, 2023, Licensee emailed a response stating he did attend the course. Board staff suggested Licensee contact the provider to resolve the discrepancies.
- 10.On November 22, 2023, Licensee emailed his registration for the course and handwritten notes. Licensee requested contact information for the SD CPA Society.
- 11. After review of the documentation provided, the Board office determined that BORK had provided satisfactory documentation of the following:
 - a. 40 CPE hours for the period commencing July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021;
 - b. 40 CPE hours for the period commencing July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; and
 - c. 32 CPE hours for the period commencing July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
- 12. On January 19, 2024, the Board's executive director issued a letter outlining the Board office's audit findings.
- 13. Based on the audit results, BORK is short 8 CPE hours for the audit period.
- 14. On January 19, 2024, the Board's executive director issued a complaint outlining the CPE audit findings and a response was due no later than February 16, 2024.

- 15. On January 19, 2024, BORK responded in an email regarding the course from the SD CPA Society that "it's their word over mine".
- 16.On February 5, 2024, Bork responded in an email regarding the course from the SD CPA Society stating a reason they don't have record of him attending as a "user error on my part".
- 17. On February 12, 2024, Daniel Nichols (Nichols), attorney for BORK, issued a written response to the complaint. In the response to the complaint BORK admitted to paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9 and 10. He denied paragraphs 8, 11, 12 and 13. He had no response to paragraph 5.
- 18. Nichols is requesting for BORK in his response numbered 6, that he not be required to comply with ARSD 20:75:04:15(1).
- 19. On February 28, 2024, the Board attorney Korson emailed Nichols, attorney for Bork, a Formal Complaint against him for failing the CPE audit. The formal complaint requested a response by March 19, 2024.
- 20. On February 28, 2024, Nichols emailed Korson, which restated his response to the written complaint.
- 21. On February 29, 2024, Korson responded reiterating the formal complaint violation is BORK not providing a certificate or other verification supplied by the CPE program sponsor as required by ARSD 20:75:04:15(1).
- 22. No response from Nichols on the Formal Complaint was received.
- 23. On March 21, 2024, the Notice of Hearing was served on Bork through his attorney of record, Nichols.
- 24.On March 22, 2024, Nichols notified Korson by email that he is no longer representing Bork.
- 25. As of the date of this Amended Notice of Hearing, no response to the Formal Complaint has been received.
