Meeting Minutes SOUTH DAKOTA ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Via Teleconference October 15, 2021 12:00 p.m. CDT

Chairman Kilmer called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m. A quorum was present.

Members Present via Telephone: Mike Kilmer, Lee Lohff, Margaret Gillespie, and Richard Little

Members Absent: Verle Valentine

Others Present via Telephone: Jennifer Stalley, executive secretary; Amber Mulder, Department of Labor, Legal Counsel, Bob Mercer, KELOLand News, and Thomas Lee, Sioux Falls Sports Authority.

Lohff made a motion to approve the agenda. Gillespie seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Kilmer asked for any public comments. Lee introduced himself to the Commission. No other comments were offered.

Lohff made a motion to approve the July 9, 2021, commission meeting minutes. Gillespie seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Gillespie made a motion to accept the financial report as of September 30, 2021. Lohff seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Kilmer noted that the executive session noticed on the agenda would not be necessary.

Stalley gave an update on previously approved events. MMA 2021-03 took place on August 20, 2021, in Sioux Falls. MMA 2021-04 took place on September 18, 2021, in Watertown. The event was a first-time promotion in South Dakota for the promoter and the first outdoor event overseen by the Commission. There are some conditions to be recommended for future events by the promoter and for outdoor venues. MMA 2021-05 is rescheduled for October 23, 2021, in Watertown.

The Commission discussed its COVID-19 polices. No changes were recommended to the policies.

Lohff made a motion to authorize the Commission to enter into a contract for an agreed-upon procedures audit. Gillespie seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Lohff made a motion to set the 2022 Commission meeting schedule for January 28, 2022; April 8, 2022; July 8, 2022; and October 21, 2022, with meetings at 12:00 pm (central). Gillespie seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Lohff made a motion to elect Kilmer as Chair of the Commission for a one-year term. Gillespie seconded the motion. There were no other nominations. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Gillespie made a motion to elect Lohff as Vice Chair of the Commission for a one-year term. Kilmer seconded the motion. There were no other nominations. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Lohff made a motion to elect Little as Secretary of the Commission for a one-year term. Gillespie seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** Little was absent.

Little made a motion to approve the 2022 exempt organization request from South Dakota USA Boxing on the condition South Dakota USA Boxing inform the Commission of any sanctioned events in South Dakota before the event takes place and South Dakota USA Boxing report all event results and any contestant injuries to the Commission within 30 days of the event. South Dakota Athletic Commission COVID-19 related policies (revised 4/30/2021)

The South Dakota Athletic Commission requires the following COVID-19 related adaptations to its requirements for a mixed martial arts, boxing or kickboxing event:

COVID-19 Testing

All competitors, corners, and officials must have a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of the event. The acceptable methods to meet this testing requirement are a PCR test or antigen test.

A competitor, corner, or official is not required to provide a negative COVID-19 test if, the competitor, corner or officials has:

- a. Proof of COVID-19 antibodies within 90 days of the event; or
- b. Proof of a COVID-19 diagnosis in the 90 days prior to the event and has a physician's statement of recovery.

Event Set Up and Operations

The required perimeter between the cage/ring and spectators may be expanded at the direction of the Commission, depending on the venue, to ensure proper distancing between the competitors, officials and spectators.

All competitors and corners are to remain in the assigned locker room upon arrival at the venue.

Venue Capacity and Restrictions

The approved event venue is responsible to determining the number of spectators and conditions for attendance by spectators at the venue.

Promoters and event venues are encouraged to ask spectators to wear masks and maintain social distancing consistent with the Centers for Disease Control's recommendations.

Application of Commission COVID-19 Policies

The Commission's COVID-19 conditions for an approved event are subject to change without notice.

BoxRec and MMA Registry Databases

Background:

BoxRec database and MMA Registry are the official reporting databases for boxing and mixed martial arts events and fighters. BoxRec is officially recognized by the Association of Boxing Commissions as the official recordkeeper for boxing results. The MMA Registry is the officially certified recordkeeper for mixed martial arts results by the Association of Boxing Commissions.

As a member of the Association of Boxing Commissions, the South Dakota Athletic Commission has access to these databases and is expected to report results, suspensions and federal identifications to and through the databases. The information contained in these databases is used to verify competitor identities and report results and suspensions, which are used by the Athletic Commission to approve or deny bouts.

The Athletic Commission requires promoters to submit their card through the applicable database. Each promoter must have a registered account with the database. The Athletic Commissioner assigned to the event approves or denies a proposed bout after reviewing the records of fighter and any suspensions in effect. Athletic Commission staff has been authorized to report results, enter suspensions and issue federal identifications through the databases, as required as a member of the Association of Boxing Commissions.

The databases allow for varying levels of access for commissioners and staff. Commissions may have one or more people with access to the databases, at the commission's discretion. To date, the Athletic Commission has maintained one account for the commission and directed all contact for the databases through the commission office.

If the Athletic Commission wishes to extend access to the database to additional points of contact for the commission, the options for access are:

All Access (All access below plus federal identifications and report results)
View licenses, view audit results, add note, upload photos, add suspensions, edit events, vacate results

View licenses, view audit results, add note, upload photos, add suspensions,
edit events, vacate results
View licenses, view audit results, add notes and upload photos
Read only (View licenses)

BoxRec allows for multiple contacts to be listed for a state commission. The contact information ranges from contacts for commission offices to individual commissioners with personal contact information. To date, the Athletic Commission has opted to list only the commission office information (address, telephone number and email address).

If the Athletic Commission wishes to add more contacts to the commission's BoxRec listing, the commission needs to determine who to list and what information to list.
