Catherine Dekkenga (standing in for Jared Carda) called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. A quorum was present.

Monthly Financial Report – Fiscal Year 2025 (Through June) Prepared for Board Members

Overview

As of June 2025, the Board's total revenues stand at **\$524,439**, while expenditures have reached **\$347,661**, resulting in a **positive net position of \$176,778**. This reflects healthy financial stewardship and indicates that current revenues are adequately supporting operational demands.

Revenue Highlights

- **Certification Renewals** continue to be the strongest revenue stream, totaling **\$343,569** (65% of total revenue), with peak collections in **January (\$64,740)** and **June (\$47,290)**.
- **Application Fees** have brought in **\$131,890**, with a notable spike in **June (\$23,700)** and consistent performance throughout the year.
- Late Fees contributed \$12,040, indicating improved compliance.
- Exam Fees totaled \$1,150, a modest contribution, reflecting stable testing activity.

Expenditure Summary

- Full-Time Salaries: \$168,457
- Board Member Fees: \$16,600
- Benefits (Health, OASI, Retirement): \$58,150

Monthly Trends

- Highest Revenue Month: January (\$84,200)
- Highest Expense Month: November (\$45,696)
- Net positive cash flow in **9 of 12 months** to date.

Conclusion & Outlook

The Board remains in a strong financial position heading into fiscal year 2026, with a current surplus of over **\$176,778**. Strategic expenditures have aligned with operational priorities.
