Case 09-06 Competency and Professional Conduct - Board adopted the OHE's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law at its 11/21/14 meeting. Stay of Board's order granted while case is under appeal.

Vice Chairman Micko gave a brief update on the status of this case. Appeal of Case is currently in process. A stay has been granted on the Order of the Board.

Board member Mike Albertson rejoined the meeting at 9:01 a.m.

Case 14-04 Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR. - Reschedule Hearing Dates - February 13, 2015 at 8:30 A.M. as primary; February 20, 2015 at 8:30 A.M. as alternate

Staff Attorney Arnold is awaiting a response from licensee's attorney on the rescheduled hearing dates.

Case 14-05 Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR. - (Hearing starts promptly at 9:00 A.M.)

Vice Chairman Micko called the scheduled hearing in the matter of Case 14-05 Failure to report Disciplinary Action on the part of David C. Baum to order at 9:04 a.m. on January 14, 2015.

The following Board members were present: Vice Chairman Dennis Micko, Secretary Steve Williams, Mike Albertson, Len Neugebauer, Steve Peters, and Drake Olson. Others present were Staff Attorney Aaron Arnold and staff members, Mark Humphreys, Kathryn Patterson and Susan Neuf.

Mr. Baum did not appear at the scheduled time of the hearing and no legal representative attended on his behalf. Mr. Baum did not send a notice of intent to attend the hearing nor a request to change the date scheduled for the hearing prior to the time that the hearing was scheduled to take place.

After presentation of testimony and exhibits to the Board, Vice Chairman Micko then closed the hearing at 9:38 a.m.

Motion: By Williams, seconded by Albertson that pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2(3) the Board will go into Executive Session for review and discussion of information provided.

Action: 6-0 AYE (Albertson, Micko, Neugebauer, Olson, Peters, and Williams)

Staff Attorney Arnold, Mark Humphreys, Kathryn Patterson, and Susan Neuf left the room during the Executive Session.

The Executive Session ended at 10:20 a.m.

The Board meeting resumed at 10:20 a.m. Staff Attorney Arnold returned to the meeting along with all persons who left the room during the Executive Session.

It is the consensus of the Board to accept the findings of fact supported by the exhibits presented. The consensus of the Board is to follow the actions taken by the Missouri Board in the Missouri Settlement Agreement Terms and conditions of the disciplinary period item numbers A, B, F, G, H, and I as well as, apply a 1 year probationary period, a \$1000 fine for perjury, and a \$1000 fine for failure to report disciplinary action. The Board also states that if licensee does not follow the Boards stipulations above that the license be suspended for 1 year if the fines are not paid within 30 days of the execution of the order.

Motion: By Williams, seconded by Albertson to accept the findings of fact and impose the fine as described above.

Case 15-01 Competency and Professional Conduct - LS.

The Investigative Committee met, reviewed complaint documents, and prepared their report. The investigation Committee's report recommends that this case be dismissed, on the basis that it does not contain sufficient evidence to show any violation by the licensee which would be worthy of disciplinary action.

Motion: By Olson, seconded by Peters to dismiss Case 15-01.

Action: 5-0 AYE (Albertson, Micko, Olson, Peters, and Williams); Neugebauer recused himself from the vote.

Case 15-03 Practice without CoA - AR.

The Investigative Committee is currently reviewing this case and an update will be given at the March Board meeting.

Case 15-04 Practice without CoA - PE.

The Investigative Committee recommends drafting a voluntary assurance agreement imposing a \$5000 fine, approval of individual license reinstatement, and approval of new business certification of authorization.

Motion: By Neugebauer, seconded by Peters to accept the recommendations of the Investigative committee on Case 15-04, that the voluntary assurance agreement be approved by the Board after review, that would require the payment of a \$5000 fine, the reinstatement of professional engineering license and eventual approval upon submittal of a certificate of authorization. Albertson amended the motion to require each Board member to agree with the voluntary assurance agreement.

Action: 5-0 AYE (Albertson, Neugebauer, Olson, Peters, and Williams); Micko recused himself from the vote.

Case 15-05 Practice without CoA - PE.

Board member Albertson was assigned to the Investigative Committee for this case.

Item 4: Cross Practice in Construction Administration. Item is in progress. Board members are reviewing a draft of Statute revisions.

Item 5: Building Officials Guide. Item is in progress. The Board is awaiting input from Building Officials.

Item 6: Rewrite Petroleum Release Exam and review experience required for Assessor and Remediator. Item is in progress. The Board is coordinating with others for input.

Item 7: Board Policy on early testing and on CoA required. Item is in progress. After a long and productive discussion, the Board and legal counsel determined that Board policy #1 regarding Comity Applicants who took the PE or PS exams early was already addressed in the law, and Board policy #2 regarding Certificate of Authorization not required for Certain Individual Licensees (i.e. those who are unemployed, those who are retired from full-time practice, etc.) needs to be added to current law. The consensus of the board was that further discussion was needed on these topics and they should be tabled until the March Board meeting.

Add **Item 8: Possible ways to make use of reserve funds.** Albertson, Olson, and Arnold will be looking for the best possible ways to make use of the reserve funds.
