Final Draft SDCL revisions

Item 1: Seals; Guideline Document - Electronic Plans Distribution - Cross Practice in Construction Administration. Item is in progress. A final draft of the seals guideline document and the proposed rules and statute changes are currently being reviewed by the Board's legal counsel. There was a motion at May 2015 board meeting to advance the law changes - this item will be removed from the action items list after the July meeting.

Item 2: Building Officials Guide. Item is in progress. Board member Williams has been in touch with building officials and reported that wording needed to be changed in SDCL 36-18A-9 (6) (c).

Item 3: Rewrite Petroleum Release Exam and review experience required for Assessor and Remediator. Item is in progress. The Board is currently waiting for input from the state regulatory agency responsible for regulating the field of Petroleum Release. Len Neugebauer and Kathryn Patterson will draft a letter requesting input and assistance on building an exam specific to the Assessor application and a separate exam specific to the Remediator application. With applicants for Remediator taking both exams.

Item 4: Possible ways to use reserve funds. The Board proposed a few suggestions on ways the Board’s reserve funds can be used to advance the technical professions. Suggestions will need to be forwarded to Board liaison for review and approval.

Item 5: Outreach to association of counties, county commissioners, and/or rural permitting agents to educate them on requirements for obtaining building / A&E services for health, safety, and welfare of the public (letter to be sent every 4 years). The Board and legal counsel researching to determine how these agencies can be educated on the State’s requirements for determining whether A&E services are required. It is the consensus of the Board that it would be beneficial to send these agencies a copy of the Building Officials Guide upon completion of the update

NCEES - Engineering Competency Model

The Lifelong Working Group of the American Association of Engineering Societies has been working with the US Department of Labor to develop an Engineering Competency Model (ECM), which establishes the base competencies required for entry into the field of engineering as well as those competencies required during one's career. The ECM was formally adopted by the AAES Board of Delegates at the April meeting and was finalized after a validator's meeting was conducted with appropriate subject matter experts and representatives from industry, government, academia, and private practice. The ECM is now published on the DOL web site.

NCEES is seeking licensed electrical and computer engineers to participate in a professional activities and knowledge study, or PAKS, for the PE electrical and Computer exams. A cross section of licensed professional engineers practicing electrical or computer engineering is required. Including those working in industry, consulting, the public sector, and academia to complete an online survey about the tasks and knowledge required of a licensed electrical or computer engineer with 4 to 6 years of experience to practice in a manner that safeguards the health, safety, and welfare of the public. The results of this online survey will be used to update specifications for the exams, which are used throughout the United States for licensing purposes. The PAKS will be used to update all three of the PE Electrical and Computer exams: Computer Engineering, Electrical and Electronics, and Power.
