- **Consistency** is so important – it is not US vs. Them
- Utilities are required to watch for permits prior to energizing a new installation.
 - Alert office if a violation occurs
- TKS – input every day
- Expense vouchers – 12/24 to 1/22. All on one. Request additional push for trip if you wish. Slow payments: You may have them printed every week if you wish.
- Who owns the permit – Owner of the property? In my opinion you are reporting on the property and not the installer.
- Air watch
- SPAM – new BIT policy
- Listing or unlisted equipment – New and moved – Tabled to Thursday
 - Equipment moved that never had a field evaluation or listing will require a field evaluation or certification.
 - Only energize permitted or listed structures/equipment

- Inspecting process for unlisted equipment:
 - 1st step – require listing
 - 2nd step – require field evaluation
 - 3rd step – received inability to list by 3rd party.
 - 4th step – assess for designation

Inspection Process

- Consistent way to inform licensees that the rough in has been completed and whether they can move on.
 - Rough in inspection with corrections – adhere yellow sticker
 - Add box: corrections required.
 - Rough in inspection passed – adhere blue sticker. Either remove yellow or place over the top of the yellow sticker.
 - Required to contact individual who requests notification.
- Document time, document Time, Document TIME: You are required to document:
 - inspections right after inspection unless special situations. FC, RFR and RFF can wait until convenient yet required within 24 hours of notification
 - information into the computer
 - additional time due to travel/poor directions
 - your day in the computer
- Document a FC with 0 number of units on your personal permit when a permit is not loaded during an inspection (RI, number of units, and mileage in remarks). Place a RI, units utilized when the inspection was actually conducted and current mileage on the permit when received.
- You are required to maintain follow up dates in a current status.
- Homeowner wiring letter – see desktop for draft. Add inspector or not? Other?
 - Added to database with spiel noted
 - You require a 72 hour notice
 - Should HO permits contact you or the office? Contact inspector.
- Really need to instruct the owners to call for an inspection when you talk to them the first time – then move out follow up date. Inspector is to set and keep current. It is the inspector's choice on what to set at and his/her responsibility to review.
- You are required to attempt to contact an owner before accessing their property.
- You are required to attempt a response within 24 hours.
- No inspections unless a permit is received and loaded.
- You may inspect special projects in special situations: assess for \$100 fee.
- You may adjust the estimated units on permits within reason
- Do not put green stickers on installations that are not compliant – FV, FS, FT, requested inspections, HO wiring under an EC permit, and equipment designated as machinery.
- You must provide the option for a FS.
- If installer/owner calls back after DT, inform them they are required to call for inspection or extend permit if not done. Document in system. Set follow up date accordingly.

- Place more documentation on HTs

Reports

- Write reports
- All inspectors should be requiring the same corrections as being documented in reports. If you do not agree with a correction, the inspector who does not agree is required to bring it to the attention to the group for discussion.
- Reports – Code requires or actual Code Section.
- You put violation code and we will create report
- Document your time writing reports
- Do not utilize terminology inconsistent with the law - nastygram
- Installations with violations which do not have to do with current permit
 - Commercial – document in report – office will create separate report
 - Residential – report for installation only with a notice provided. Green sticker with installation only.
- Please document receipt on reports tab for both IR and CO when notification for corrections is received for CO.
- Do not issue COs on HO permits
- FV once IR expires - No CO.

Fee Process

- Reinspection fee vs. Minimum fee
- Charge for your time
- Inspectors/Staff are absolutely not allowed to eliminate an assessed fee without permission from JJ.
- Units of time – Let's discuss units of time and when to assess.
- Do not inspect unless fees are paid.
- Administrative Fees
 - Recuperate cost
 - Failure to notify:
 - Utilize fee when no notification on old permit
 - Utilize fee when someone needs an inspection immediately
- DTs without notice documented will receive "Failure to Notify"
- Final small installations with one inspection per ECs request.
 - Finishing a basement may not qualify
- Three year old permits down to 1 year – for now let's shoot for 2 years. Please finalize permits that are outstanding longer than two years. Move the follow up date, inform installers of their duties, and document that you have control of the permit and document spiel in remarks.

Documentation of Inspections

- Daily contacts – JJ – review for FS/FV. More than one violation.
- Everyone is to have a personal permit.
- When to use FS or FV – See inspectors manual

- P – Use when you went for a RI or Final and couldn't do one.
- RI or IR – Use RI when the inspection passes the rough in inspection. Document with an IR if a report is written requiring corrections.
- F or IR – Use F when the inspection passes the final inspection. Use IR when you cannot final due to corrections or you have adhered green stickers with minor items pending.
- Do not FV or FT a commercial or non-owner occupied installation.
- Inspection Documentation – Inspector Manual
 - P, RI, F, IR, RI, CO, DO, HT, FC

- Decision: The Commission will only conduct RI inspections when a house is in compliance with 110.11 Structure status before a RI will be conducted:
 - Windows/Doors installed or openings enclosed with plywood, tarps or Tyvek.
 - Structure wrapped in Tyvek or similar material.
 - Shingles, tin, steel, or other roofing material installed (tar paper does not satisfy this requirement).
 - Soffits installed or soffit area enclosed.
Note: Enclosures for windows, doors and soffits which protect the installation from the elements are acceptable.
- Four unit apartment – Tim
 - 110.24 Available Fault Current.
 - (A) Field Marking. Service equipment at other than dwelling units shall be legibly marked in the field with the maximum available fault current.

Code Guidance

The following are provided as a courtesy because they are commonly referenced electrical wiring codes from South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) and National Electrical Codes.

- 110.11 Structure status before a RI will be conducted:
 - Windows/Doors installed or openings enclosed with plywood, tarps or Tyvek.
 - Structure wrapped in Tyvek or similar material.
 - Shingles, tin, steel, or other roofing material installed (tar paper does not satisfy this requirement).
 - Soffits installed or soffit area enclosed.
Note: Enclosures for windows, doors and soffits which protect the installation from the elements are acceptable.
- 210.52 & 20:44:22:23 If the back of a cabinet(s) is butted up to a stud wall, it is not considered an island or peninsula. Therefore the requirements in 210.52 pertain. (Note: recommend to install a circuit to be available for future utilization where not required.)
- 210.8 GFCI and AFCI receptacles in cabinets are considered readily acceptable unless behind an appliance.
- 210.8 A 10 - Guidance is to treat washing machine like a sink in a laundry area.
- 210.8 A 10 - Guidance is a cabinet is not considered a door, doorway or window.
- 210.8 B & 551.71 F 30 and 50 amp GFCI on pedestals – No GFCI required for residential, RV park (two or more), farmstead
- 210.12, Art. 100 and 90.4 - Specialty resort installations containing the 4 elements of a dwelling unit will be required to utilize AFCIs. (Permanent provisions for living, sleeping, cooking and sanitation).
- 210.12 A - AFCI is not required for 120V furnace circuit.
- 210.12 A - Outlets or devices which would include switches are required to be AFCI protected.
- 210.23 A 2 - Please note manufacturer's instructions for appliances and/or the 50 percent rule may require an appliance circuit to be dedicated.
- 210.52 A 2 1 – Outlets below the work surface satisfy the wall space requirement.
- 7 and under rooms
- 250.52 UFFER Ground - required to be connected to foundation or footing.
- 445.13 - The exception clarifies generators with breakers can be derated at 100 percent.
- 517 Chiropractor Office – Human medical would include chiropractor, eye
- 590 - All temporary power receptacles require GFCI protection.
- 680.42 C The 2017 NEC now allows NM cable to be installed between the service panel and the breakers disconnect for the outdoor hot tub.
- 702.4B2 - Utilize this article when sizing a generator utilizing an automatic transfer switch.
- Shunt trip breakers for "Machine Roomless" passenger elevators may be located in the elevator or in the building machine room
- Mini-split cable EC or HVAC installer – HVAC may install (listed assembly) yet required to follow manufacturer's instructions

Common Violations

- Wiring Bulletin - Grounding electrode conductor must terminate at the neutral bar in the service.
- NEC 110.24 requires service equipment in other than dwelling units to have the available fault current labeled. The label shall have the date the calculation was figured and shall be able to withstand the environment involved.
- Size over current protection per name plate on equipment. Example air conditioner.
- NEC 406 Install weather resistant receptacles.
- NEC 408.4 - Labeling breakers

Changing Services

- Current service locations are not grandfathered
- 110.26 – Access and working space shall be provided and maintained about all electrical equipment to permit ready and safe operation and maintenance of equipment.
- 210.12 If circuits are modified, replaced or extended over six feet, AFCI protection is required.
- S.D. Wiring Bulletin - Service conductors extending over five feet in a building could be run in rigid metal conduit up to 15 feet.
- 240.24(f) Services cannot be located in stairways, bathrooms, clothes closets, etc.

Documentation of Rough in Process

- Rough in inspection with corrections – yellow sticker
- Rough in inspection approved – adhere blue sticker. (Yellow sticker removed or blue sticker adhered over yellow sticker.)

***Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest
Policy for Use By
State Authority, Board,
Commission, and Committee Members***

The State Board of Internal Controls has been working on a code of conduct for board/commission members for that past year or so. They have finalized a code; please see the attached. No formal action needs to be taken, unless the Commission wants to amend it in some way. As the underlined sentence in the first paragraph indicates, any changes beyond style and form must be taken to SBIC for approval.

Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest Policy for Use By State Authority, Board, Commission, and Committee Members

Purpose

The purpose of this code of conduct and conflict of interest policy (“Code”) is to establish a set of minimum ethical principles and guidelines for members of state authorities, boards, commissions, or committees when acting within their official public service capacity. With the exception of those under the purview of the Unified Judicial System, this Code applies to all appointed and elected members of state authorities, boards, commissions, and committees (hereinafter “Boards” and “Board member(s)”). A Board may add provisions to, or modify the provisions of, the Code. However, any change that constitutes a substantive omission from the Code must be approved by the State Board of Internal Control.

Conflict of Interest for Board Members

Board members may be subject to statutory restrictions specific to their Boards found in state and federal laws, rules and regulations. Those restrictions are beyond the scope of this Code. Board members should contact their appointing authority or the attorney for the Board for information regarding restrictions specific to their Board.

General Restrictions on Participation in Board Actions

A conflict of interest exists when a Board member has an interest in a matter that is different from the interest of members of the general public. Examples of circumstances which may create a conflict of interest include a personal or pecuniary interest in the matter or an existing or potential employment relationship with a party involved in the proceeding.

Whether or not a conflict of interest requires a Board member to abstain from participation in an official action of the Board depends upon the type of action involved. A Board’s official actions are administrative, quasi-judicial or quasi-legislative.

A quasi-judicial official action is particular and immediate in effect, such as a review of an application for a license or permit. In order to participate in a quasi-judicial official action of the Board, a Board member must be disinterested and free from actual bias or an unacceptable risk of actual bias. A Board member must abstain from participation in the discussion and vote on a quasi-judicial official action of the Board if a reasonably-minded person could conclude that there is an unacceptable risk that the Board member has prejudged the matter or that the Board member’s interest or relationship creates a potential to influence the member’s impartiality.

A quasi-legislative official action, also referred to as a regulatory action, is general and future in effect. An example is rule-making. If the official action involved is quasi-legislative in nature, the Board member is not required to abstain from participation in the discussion and vote on the action unless it is clear that the member has an unalterably closed mind on matters critical to the disposition of the action.

Administrative actions involve the day-to-day activities of the Board and include personnel, financing, contracting and other management actions. Most of the administrative official actions of a Board are done through the Board's administrative staff. To the extent Board members are involved, the conflict of interest concern most frequently arises in the area of state contracting which is addressed in more detail below. If issues arise that are not directly addressed by this Code, the Board member should consult with the attorney for the Board.

"Official action" means a decision, recommendation, approval, disapproval or other action which involves discretionary authority. A Board member who violates any of these restrictions may be subject to removal from the Board to which the member is appointed.

Contract Restrictions

There are federal and state laws, rules and regulations that address conflict of interest for elected and appointed Board members in the area of contracts. As an initial matter, a Board member may not solicit or accept any gift, favor, reward, or promise of reward, including any promise of future employment, in exchange for recommending, influencing or attempting to influence the award of or the terms of a state contract. This prohibition is absolute and cannot be waived.

Members of certain Boards are required to comply with additional conflict of interest provisions found in SDCL Chapter 3-23 and are required to make an annual disclosure of any contract in which they have or may have an interest or from which they derive a direct benefit. The restrictions apply for one year following the end of the Board member's term. The Boards impacted by these laws are enumerated within SDCL 3-23-10. For more information on these provisions, see the State Authorities/Boards/Commissions page in the Legal Resources section of the Attorney General's website at: <http://atg.sd.gov/legal/opengovernment/authorityboardcommission.aspx>.

Absent a waiver, certain Board members are further prohibited from deriving a direct benefit from a contract with an outside entity if the Board member had substantial involvement in recommending, awarding, or administering the contract or if the Board member supervised another state officer or employee who approved, awarded or administered the contract. With the exception of employment contracts, the foregoing prohibition applies for one year following the end of the Board member's term. However, the foregoing prohibition does not apply to Board members who serve without compensation or who are only paid a per diem. See SDCL 5-18A-17 to 5-18A-17.6. For more information on these restrictions see the Conflict of Interest Waiver Instructions and Form on the South Dakota Bureau of Human Resources website at: <http://bhr.sd.gov/forms/>.

Other federal and state laws, rules and regulations may apply to specific Boards. For general questions regarding the applicability of SDCL Chapter 3-23 or other laws, a Board member may

contact the attorney for the Board. However, because the attorney for the Board does not represent the Board member in his or her individual capacity, a Board member should contact a private attorney if the member has questions as to how the conflict of interest laws apply to the Board member's own interests and contracts.

Consequences of Violations of Conflict of Interest Laws

A contract entered into in violation of conflict of interest laws is voidable and any benefit received by the Board member is subject to disgorgement. In addition, a Board member who violates conflict of interest laws may be removed from the Board and may be subject to criminal prosecution. For example, a Board member may be prosecuted for theft if the member knowingly uses funds or property entrusted to the member in violation of public trust and the use resulted in a direct financial benefit to the member. See SDCL 3-16-7, 5-18A-17.4, and 22-30-46.

Retaliation for Reporting

A Board cannot dismiss, suspend, demote, decrease the compensation of, or take any other retaliatory action against an employee because the employee reports, in good faith, a violation or suspected violation of a law or rule, an abuse of funds or abuse of authority, a substantial and specific danger to public health or safety, or a direct criminal conflict of interest, unless the report is specifically prohibited by law. SDCL 3-16-9 & 3-16-10.

Board members will not engage in retaliatory treatment of an individual because the individual reports harassment, opposes discrimination, participates in the complaint process, or provides information related to a complaint. See SDCL 20-13-26.

Anti-Harassment/Discrimination Policy

While acting within their official capacity, Board members will not engage in harassment or discriminatory or offensive behavior based on race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, pregnancy, age, ancestry, genetic information, disability or any other legally protected status or characteristic.

Harassment includes conduct that creates a hostile work environment for an employee or another Board member. This prohibition against harassment and discrimination also encompasses sexual harassment. Sexual harassment includes unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexually harassing nature, when: (1) submission to or rejection of the harassment is made either explicitly or implicitly the basis of or a condition of employment, appointment, or a favorable or unfavorable action by the Board member; or (2) the harassment has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's work performance or creating an intimidating, hostile, or offensive working environment.

Harassment or discriminatory or offensive behavior may take different forms and may be verbal, nonverbal, or physical in nature. To aid Board members in identifying inappropriate conduct, the following examples of harassment or discriminatory or offensive behavior are provided:

- Unwelcome physical contact such as kissing, fondling, hugging, or touching;

- Demands for sexual favors; sexual innuendoes, suggestive comments, jokes of a sexual nature, sexist put-downs, or sexual remarks about a person's body; sexual propositions, or persistent unwanted courting;
- Swearing, offensive gestures, or graphic language made because of a person's race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age or disability;
- Slurs, jokes, or derogatory remarks, email, or other communications relating to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, or disability; or
- Calendars, posters, pictures, drawings, displays, cartoons, images, lists, e-mails, or computer activity that reflects disparagingly upon race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age or disability.

The above cited examples are not intended to be all-inclusive.

A Board member who is in violation of this policy may be subject to removal from the Board.

Confidential Information

Except as otherwise required by law, Board members shall not disclose confidential information acquired during the course of their official duties. In addition, members are prohibited from the use of confidential information for personal gain.

Reporting of Violations

Any violation of this Code should be reported to the appointing authority for the Board member who is alleged to have violated the Code.

This Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest Policy was adopted by the State Board of Internal Control pursuant to SDCL § 1-56-6.

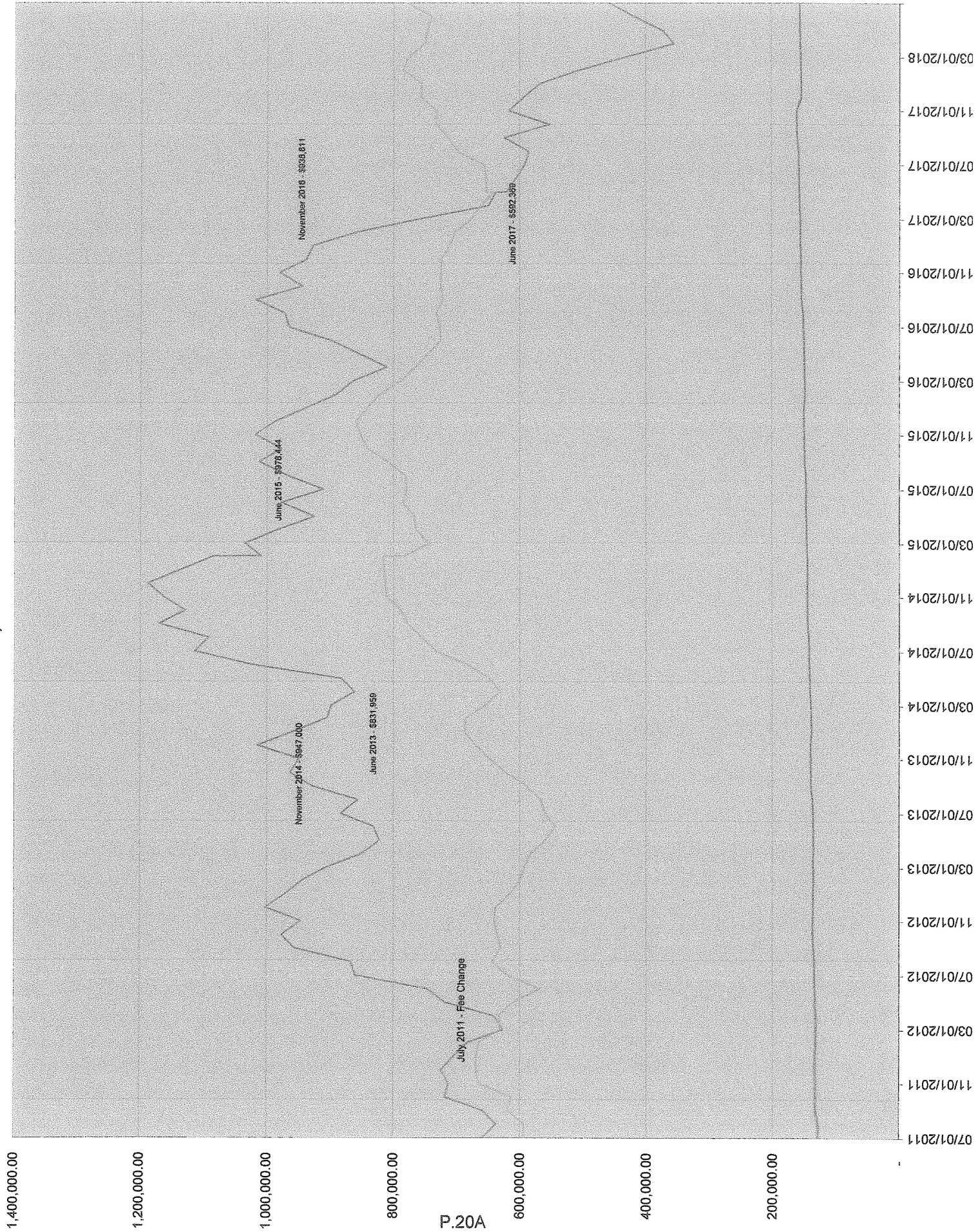
