Dear Mr. Anderson,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a non-resident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license on August 23, 2013. Your application indicated that you were not involved in any prior administrative actions. However, the Division's investigation revealed you were subject to an administrative action in the state of Oklahoma in 2009. The Division contacted you regarding the incorrect answer on your license application and we received a response from Carla Dawson stating that you were unable to obtain documentation from the Oklahoma Insurance Department because they have no record of the action. The Division received correspondence from you on September 6, 2013 stating that you were not aware of the action prior to August 26, 2013. The Division contacted the Oklahoma Insurance Department and on September 11, 2013 we received a copy of the Administrative Order from Oklahoma. On September 12, 2013, the Division received a voicemail from Carla Dawson indicating that you had spoken to Oklahoma and Oklahoma told you that they do not have any documentation. The Division sent you a letter at the mailing address listed on your application, PO Box 5970, Mesa, AZ 85211-5970, on September 17, 2013 requesting that you provide the documentation. You did not respond.

Therefore, your application is denied based upon SDCL 58-30-167 (1), (2), and (3) for providing incorrect, misleading, or incomplete information in your application and attempting to obtain a license through misrepresentation or fraud.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the data base maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
