RE: Application for Reinstatement of Resident Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Kyburz,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You were previously a licensed resident insurance producer. You allowed your license to lapse on November 30, 2016. Later in 2016, you submitted an application for reinstatement of your individual resident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division"). On your answer to the application question concerning child support, you indicated that you have a child support obligation in arrearage.

The Division wrote to you and spoke with you in the intervening months about the child support matter. Today the Division contacted the Department of Social Services and confirmed again that your obligations are remain in arrearage.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL §§ 25-7A-56 and 58-30-167(13) for failure to comply with an administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation. You therefore remain unlicensed to sell, solicit, or negotiate insurance in South Dakota.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
