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RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Amsbaugh,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on July 9, 2018. On your answer to the application question concerning administrative actions, you indicated you had been involved in an administrative proceeding. On you answer to the application question concerning misdemeanor convictions, you indicated you had misdemeanor convictions. The required additional documentation for the administrative action and misdemeanor convictions was not attached to your application.

The Division wrote to you on July 17, 2018 to request a copy of the administrative actions and a written explanation regarding inconsistent, incomplete, and incorrect information that were submitted. You responded to the Division on July 17, 2018 with the requested documents, including documentation of your long criminal history.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL §§ 58-30-167(1), (2), and (8) for incompleteness, for violating another state's insurance laws, and for using dishonest practices and demonstrating untrustworthiness in the conduct of business.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
