RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Ms. Brunson,

This letter is to notify you that your renewal application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted a renewal application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on October 17, 2017. On your answer to the application questions concerning criminal background, you indicated that you were the subject of two past prosecutions. No documentation was supplied for the 2013 criminal prosecution, as required in the application.

The Division wrote to you on October 25, 2017 and November 27, 2017 via e-mail and in hard copy to your mailing address. Through mail tracking, the Division has confirmed that you received at least one of those letters. To date, there has been no information provided by you regarding that action or the application.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL § 58-30-167(1) for incompleteness.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
