RE: Denial of Insurance Producer License

Dear Ms. Manahan,

This letter is to notify you the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") is denying your non-resident insurance producer application, which was submitted to the Division on March 9, 2018. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You answered "yes" to having been convicted of a felony on your application. However, you did not provide all of the required documentation on the felony conviction(s). The Division wrote to you on March 28, 2018 requesting the missing information. You did respond and upload documents to the NIPR Warehouse; however, there were still a couple of missing pages.

Due to the above, your license application is denied pursuant to SDCL §§ 58-30-167(1) and (6) for providing incomplete information in an application and for having been convicted of a felony.

Please note this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your license.
