RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Vojvoda,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on June 14, 2021. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "Yes" to the questions concerning misdemeanor and felony convictions. You provided documentation with your application showing that you have been convicted of conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a felony offense. On your answers to the application questions, you answered "No" to the question concerning administrative actions. However, you provided documentation with your application that you were the subject of an administrative action from the state of California on January 21, 2020, where California denied your application for an unrestricted license and issued to you a restricted license. While your application was pending, you were also the subject of administrative action on October 6, 2021 from the state of Florida, where Florida denied your application for licensure.

Due to this, the Division wrote to you on August 19, 2021 via email to request an explanation regarding incorrect, misleading, or incomplete information that was submitted, a copy of the California administrative action, and a written statement explaining the circumstances of the administrative action. After receiving no response, the Division wrote to you on October 21, 2021 via email, regular mail, and certified mail requesting a response from you. To date, the Division has not received a response from you.

Based on the above information, your application is denied based upon SDCL 58-30-167(1), (2), (6), and (9) for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application; violating the insurance laws or rules of the State of South Dakota and another state; having been convicted of a felony; and having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in another state.

Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
