RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Ms. Perevosnik,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as an insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application to the South Dakota Division of Insurance (“Division”) for an individual insurance producer license on April 23, 2022. You answered “yes” regarding questions about past crimes. The Division conducted an investigation of your application, where you provided none of the required documentation. The Division requested documentation on July 26, 2022 and August 23, 2022. The Division contacted you by phone, where you disclosed a personal event that had sidetracked you. We were told a new address for you, but this was not updated in our application system. You had indicated your intent to withdraw your application verbally, but, to date, the Division has received no request to withdraw your pending application or any written responses regarding your application.

Based on the above information, your application is denied under SDCL 58-30-167(1) for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application. Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
