Application for Insurance Producer License

Mr. Schumacher,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as an insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") for an individual insurance producer license on January 2, 2023. You answered "yes" regarding questions about misdemeanors and felonies. The Division conducted an investigation of your application, where you provided documentation showing crimes involving criminal sexual conduct and driving under the influence of alcohol. The documentation you provided showed a felony conviction where at one point you were prohibited from contacting minors. You were jailed and completed probation.

Based on the above information, your application is denied under SDCL 58-30-167(6) for having been convicted of a felony. Please note that this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your application for licensure.
