RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Palmer,

This letter is to notify you that your application for licensure as a nonresident insurance producer in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You applied for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance (“Division”) on November 12, 2024. On your answers to the application questions, you answered “Yes” to the questions concerning felony convictions. You provided documentation showing you were charged with or plead guilty felony possession of a gun on school property, felony aggravated child abuse, felony aggravated kidnapping, as well as felony conspiracy charges for the same conduct. You also initially failed to provide all the required documentation regarding your criminal record. On November 13, 2024, the Division emailed you regarding the missing documents from your application. You responded and provided the missing documents on November 15, 2024.

Based on the above information, your application is denied because you have been determined not to be in good standing under ARSD 20:06:01:03 and based upon SDCL 58-30-167 (1),(2),(6), for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application, violating any insurance laws or rules; and for having been convicted of a felony.

This denial is considered an administrative action and will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. When an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to all states in which an insurance license is held in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.
