RE: DMPO License Application

Health Choice Inc.,

This letter is to notify you that your application for a Discount Medical Plan Organization (“DMPO”) license in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

Your company submitted an application for a DMPO license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance (“Division”) on July 21, 2025. The company failed to provide any supporting documentation with the application.

Due to this missing information, the Division wrote to you via email on August 29, 2025, asking for the missing documentation. Having failed to receive a response, on November 14, 2025, the Division again wrote to you, this time via email, first class, and certified mail, requesting a response and the missing documentation. Having again failed to receive a response, on December 31, 2025, the Division attempted to call, but no one answered, and the Division could not leave a voicemail. The Division again emailed and advised that if a response was not received within 5 days, the pending application would be denied. As of the date of this letter, the Division still has not received a response.

Based on the above information, your application is denied pursuant to SDCL 58-17E-14, 58-30-167 (2), & (8), and 58-33-66.

This denial is considered an administrative action and will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. You may be required to report the action in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state in which you hold an insurance license.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your license application.
