RE: Application for Insurance Producer License

This letter is to notify you that your application for an insurance producer license in South Dakota has been denied. The reason for the denial is as follows:

You submitted an application for an insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on February 14, 2026. On the application, you answered "Yes" to question numbers 1a, 1b, and 6 regarding misdemeanor convictions, felony convictions, and termination of an insurance company appointment. You submitted information regarding your misdemeanor conviction of possession, felony conviction of conspiracy to distribute a Schedule II controlled substance, and termination of an insurance company appointment due to falsification.

Based on the above information, your application is denied pursuant to SDCL 58-30-167 (2), (6), & (8) and ARSD 20:06:01:03 and 20:06:01:04 for not being in good standing.

This denial is considered an administrative action and will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. You may be required to report the action in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state in which you hold an insurance license.

Pursuant to SDCL 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your license application.
