CONSENT ORDER
LICENSE REVOCATION

In resolution of the above matter and in lieu of issuance of a Notice of Hearing and a formal hearing, the undersigned parties do hereby agree to the following:

JUSTIN REZATTO, with an address of record is 110 6th Ave. SE, STE 201, Aberdeen, SD 57401, holds an insurance producer license in the State of South Dakota;

JUSTIN REZATTO is aware that the South Dakota Division of Insurance (Division) has conducted an investigation into their insurance related business;

The Division alleges the following with regard to JUSTIN REZATTO:

1. JUSTIN REZATTO was the subject of consumer complaints regarding insurer cancellations due to failure to remit premiums;
2. JUSTIN REZATTO failed to timely remit premiums from the client trust account to insurers and misappropriated premiums, in violation of SDCL 58-30-88, 58-30-167(2), (4), (7), & (8), and 58-33-35,
3. JUSTIN REZATTO was the subject of a 2006 Consent Order regarding failure to remit premiums and misappropriation of premiums, including a period of license suspension, a monetary penalty, and a Fiduciary Responsibility and Trust Accounting Requirement;
4. JUSTIN REZATTO is not in compliance with the Director's Order of 2006, in violation of SDCL 58-30-167(2);
5. The Director of the Division may revoke JUSTIN REZATTO's insurance producer license for any one of the above-cited violations.

JUSTIN REZATTO is aware of and understands the nature of the allegations and has been informed that they have the right to a Notice of Hearing, counsel, and appeal, and that by signing this Consent Order, waives these rights;

In return for JUSTIN REZATTO agreeing to, signing, and complying with the provisions of this Consent Order, the Division agrees not to proceed to administrative hearing and agrees that this Consent Order will constitute an informal disposition of this licensing matter pursuant to SDCL 1-26-20;

JUSTIN REZATTO waives their right to contest the allegations contained in this Consent Order in any future actions or licensing procedures;

JUSTIN REZATTO agrees to the voluntary revocation of their insurance producer license in the State of South Dakota and to cease insurance business in this State; and

JUSTIN REZATTO further agrees that this Consent Order may be considered for the purpose of determining the appropriate sanction in any future actions with the Division for any violations of the laws or regulations of the State of South Dakota or for failing to abide by any order of the Director;

Wherefore, good cause appearing from the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED that the insurance producer license of JUSTIN REZATTO is hereby REVOKED as of the effective date of this Consent Order; and it is further


ORDERED that JUSTIN REZATTO abide by the agreements made by them in this Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the use of this Consent Order for competitive purposes by an insurance agent or third-party administrator holding a license in the State of South Dakota, or by any company holding a Certificate of Authority, or by anyone on their behalf, may be deemed unfair competition and be grounds for suspension or revocation of said license or authority; and it is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Consent Order shall be effective from the date the Director signs this Order.


