


Instructions for Finding South Dakota Population Data (total population figures) in the Virtual Labor Market Data System



3. Click in the Geography Type box to change to or add data for other areas (U.S., state, county, Census Places or MSAS)

4. Click in the Area Name box, then select the specific area(s) of interest.

If you prefer, you may click in the “Select Areas By Map” box to select the region data.

5. Only annual population data is available, so leave the Time Period Type set to the default of “Annual.”

6. Click in the “Select Time Period” box and select the years of data you would like.

7. The only source of population data is the U.S. Census Bureau, so leave the Population Source set to the default.
