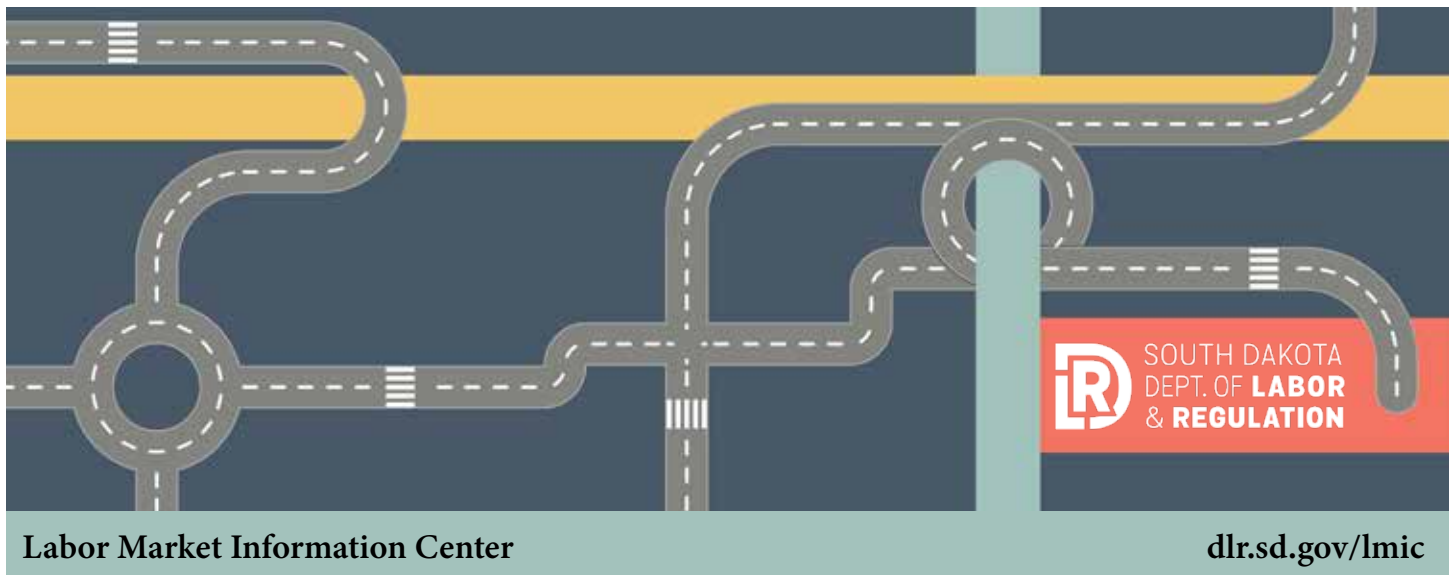

South Dakota Career Peeks

Grades K-2, available online only as PDF download, updated in 2019
Loose-leaf packet of career awareness activities. Each page explains a different career and includes a related activity integrating basic academics. An answer key and bonus materials also available online.



South Dakota Career Aware

Grades 3-5, available online only as PDF download, updated in 2019
Loose-leaf booklet introducing students to in-demand career options. Caleb the career bug helps students explore careers in 16 career clusters as they complete simple, fun activities. An answer key is also available online.



South Dakota Career Wonders

Grades 5-8, available online only as PDF download, updated in 2017
Includes a career interest survey and highlights the 16 career clusters to help students begin determining what careers might interest them. It contains a monthly budget activity and articles on topics ranging from planning for high school to preparing for the world of work.



South Dakota Career Interest Survey

Grade 6-adult

This career interest assessment can be completed and scored electronically in Microsoft Excel or manually in printed format. The survey presents work-related activities and asks the individual to rate how much they would like or dislike doing each. Tallied responses inform the individual which of the six Holland-based career areas may be of greatest interest. To explore occupations identified, links are provided to LMIC's virtual information system.



Virtual LMI System

The virtual labor market information (LMI) system provides a variety of workforce information at your fingertips, including graphs and maps of selected data. Easily compile a customized profile on occupations, explore available education, find South Dakota wage, employment and projected outlook data, plus much more. Does not require login credentials.

The virtual system presents a wealth of information on each occupation, including state-specific employment, outlook and wage data.

[Explore Occupations by Holland \(RIASEC\) Interest Area](#) - Individuals who have completed the South Dakota Career Interest Survey or another interest assessment providing results on the Holland (RIASEC) interest areas can view a list of occupations in each of the six interest groups. By clicking on any specific occupation, individuals can explore it in the virtual system.

[Hot Career resources](#) - For each of the 69 Hot Careers (high demand/high wage) occupations and the Top 30 Careers (highest 30 demand/high wage), users can learn more in the virtual system and view current job openings in the occupation.
