

Healthy component of South Dakota's workforce

The Health Care industry is an important part of South Dakota's economic baseline, accounting for 16% of all workers in privately owned establishments and nearly 20% of payrolls.

With readings climbing

South Dakota's Health Care industry added more than 9,000 workers (18%) over the last 10 years, more than any other private industry.

There are almost 3,500 South Dakota job openings in Health Care occupations right now.

Charting expected to continue upward

The Health Care industry is projected to be among the state's largest growth industries to 2032, adding nearly 8,000 workers to the state's economy with a growth rate exceeding 13%. Outstanding career opportunities await South Dakota's future Health Care workforce.



VITALS in detail

- ★ South Dakota's Health Care industry is an important source of employment, with 61,238 workers (16.0% of all workers in privately owned establishments) in 2024.
- Health Care also plays a big role in earnings, accounting for **19.8% of** the state's privately owned establishment **payrolls** in 2024.
- The number of workers in South Dakota's Health Care industry increased 18.2% from 2014 to 2024, adding 9,420 workers to the state's economy.
- South Dakota's Health Care industry is **projected to add 7,950 workers** by 2032 (from a level of 60,196 in 2022 to 68,146 in 2032, a **13.2%** increase).
- ★ Several of South Dakota's occupations projected to be in **greatest demand** through 2032 are Health Care careers, as shown in the table below.
- And the majority of those high-demand occupations (highlighted in gold below) have been identified as **South Dakota Hot Careers** (high-demand and high-wage occupations). Hot Career occupations have greater than average projected demand (more than 82 openings per year) and an average wage greater than \$45,620 (the median wage across all occupations in 2024).
