# **Dental Assistants**

### **What They Do**

Dental assistants provide patient care, take x rays, keep records and schedule appointments. They provide assistance to dentists and dental hygienists as needed. For example, they prepare patients for treatment, sterilize or disinfect instruments, set up instrument trays or assist dentist during dental procedures.
