Department of Labor and Regulation Releases Mobile-friendly Job Search Site

PIERRE, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation has rolled out a mobile-friendly version of SDWORKS, the state’s largest jobs database. The new site provides faster download speeds, portability and connectivity to job seekers.

“Creating a website optimized for tablets and smartphones caters to a large portion of our job seekers and offers a more convenient way of searching for work,” said state Labor and Regulation Secretary Marcia Hultman.

The updated site also features expanded search capabilities which include:

- Geographical range searching – Users can select a zip code and define a mileage radius they wish to search.
- Military Occupational Classifications – Allows veterans to search for jobs using their Military Occupational Classification Code.

In 2014, over 20 percent of users to www.sdjobs.org visited via tablet or mobile device.

“With many people relying solely on their mobile devices to access the Internet, this site allows us to keep up with the needs of the people and businesses we serve,” said Secretary Hultman.
