Department of Labor and Regulation Offers Help with Employer Services

PIERRE, S.D. – The Department of Labor and Regulation (DLR) offers many employer services for businesses and non-profit organizations at the local level to assist with workforce recruitment efforts.

Employers and business owners are encouraged to speak with an employment representative to see how DLR can help. Services include job fairs, resource rooms for interviews, labor market information, worker recruitment tools and applicant screening.

“I encourage employers to visit a local office and take advantage of the services we offer,” said state Labor and Regulation Secretary Marcia Hultman. “I think they will be pleasantly surprised at how much DLR can help them.”

Additional services offered at all DLR local offices include on-the-job training, labor law information, veterans’ services and South Dakota’s largest jobs database SDWORKS.

“Employers should list their openings with SDWORKS, as this increases job seeker awareness and provides better data on workforce trends,” said Secretary Hultman.
