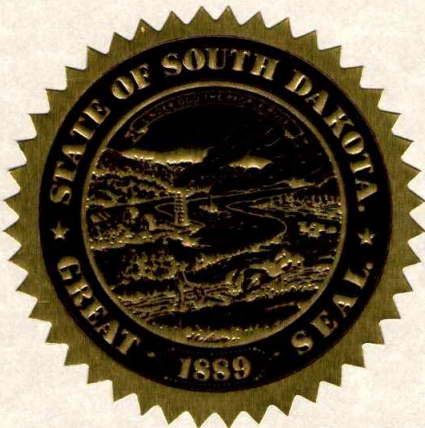

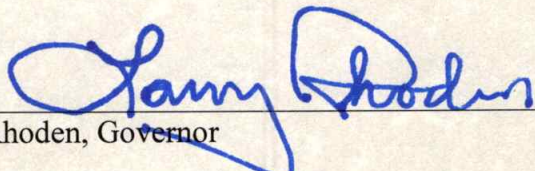
Now, Therefore, I, Larry Rhoden, Governor of the State of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim April 26, 2026, as

NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP WEEK

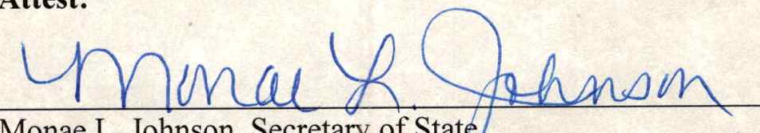
