A Federal Bill, Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Act of 1996, was passed and established State New Hire Reporting programs and a National Directory of New Hires. Through the cooperative efforts of the SD Department of Labor and Regulation (DLR) Unemployment Insurance (UI) Division and the SD Department of Social Services (DSS), Division of Child Support, the SD New Hire Reporting Center was established.

Since the introduction, over 2 million new hire reports have been received.

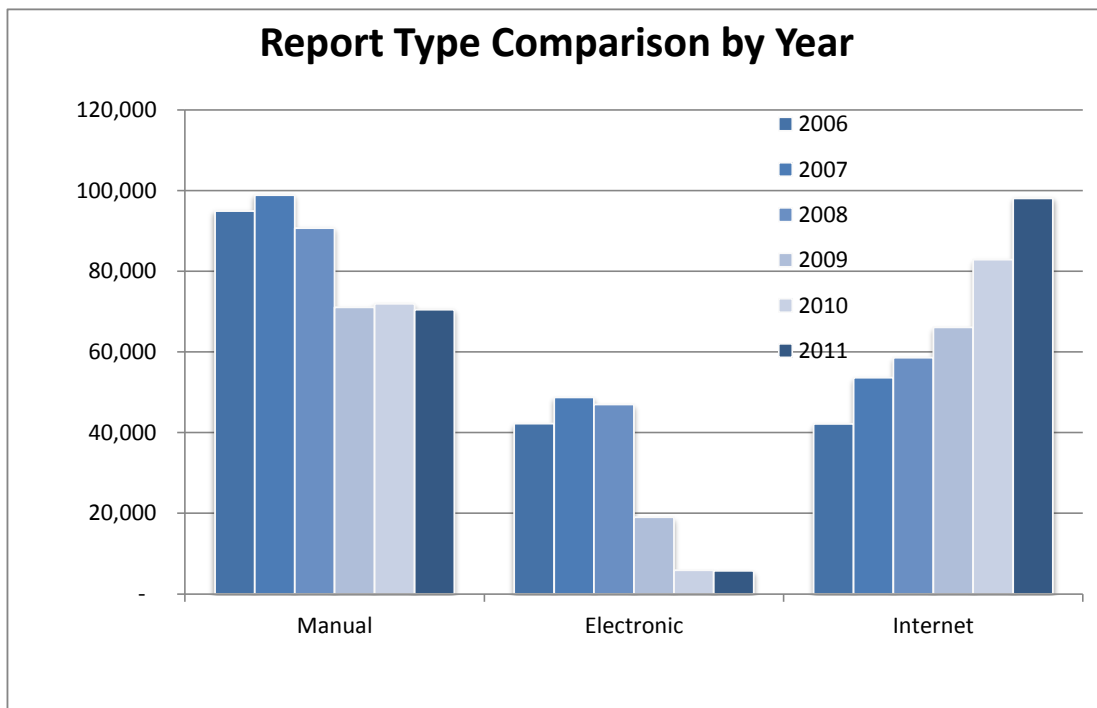
New Hire Reports By Type

% Absent Parents – The percentage of New Hire reports that resulted in a match to an absent parent

% Total Cases – The percentage of New Hire reports that resulted in a match to a child support case (Some absent parents may have multiple cases)
