

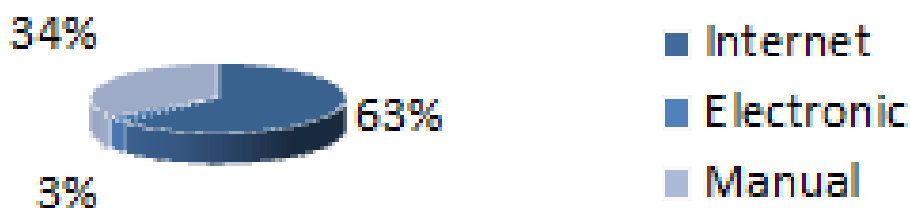

A Federal Bill, Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Act of 1996, was passed and established state New Hire Reporting programs and a National Directory of New Hires. Through the cooperative efforts of the South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation (DLR) Unemployment Insurance (UI) Division and the South Dakota Department of Social Services (DSS) Division of Child Support, the South Dakota New Hire Reporting Center was established.

Since the introduction, over 2.5 million new hire reports have been received.

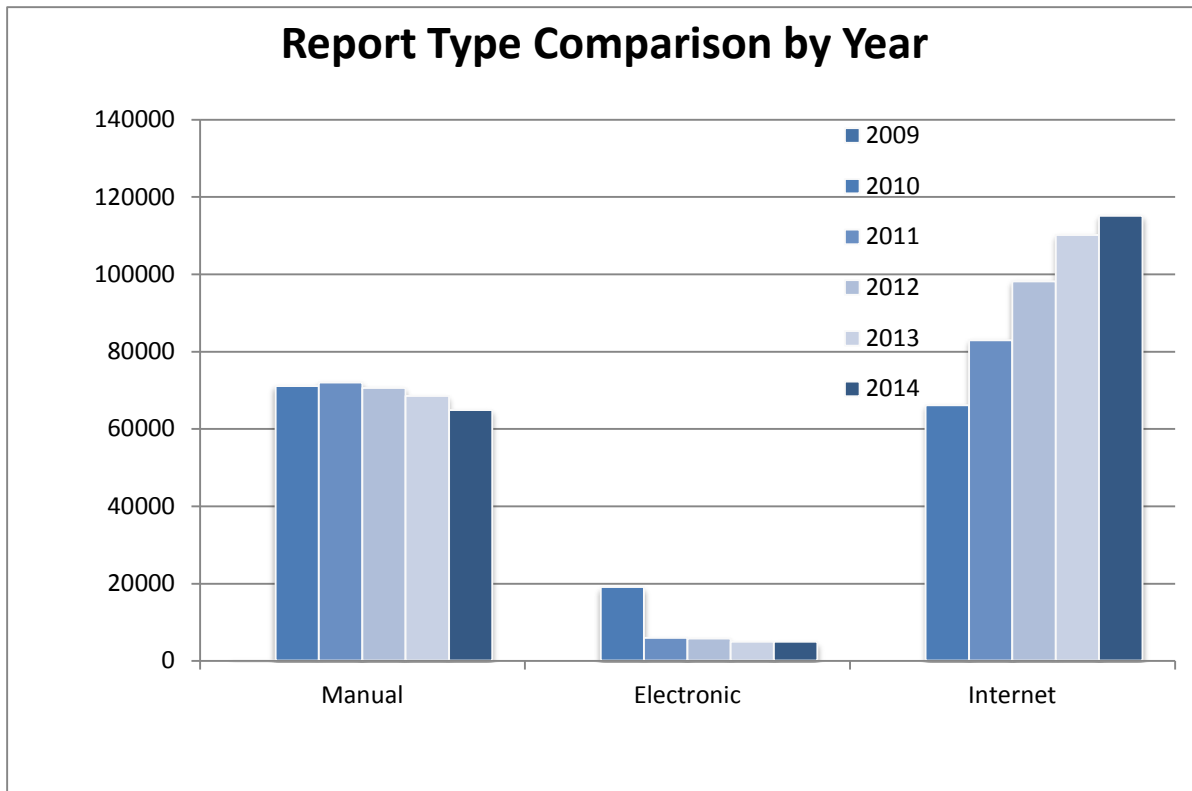
New Hire Reports by Type
