Are an employee with reduced hours or wages (including hourly and tipped employees) OR have been furloughed and will be returning to your job.	Regular unemployment benefits (26 weeks)	- \$600/week on top of your regular unemployment benefits - Up to 13 additional weeks of expanded unemployment benefits	File a claim online and request payment every week
Are an employee that has been laid off permanently with no intention of returning to your job.	Regular unemployment benefits (26 weeks)	- \$600/week on top of your regular unemployment benefits - Up to 13 additional weeks of expanded unemployment benefits	File a claim online and request payment every week
Are an employee that has exhausted regular unemployment benefits.	Regular unemployment benefits already paid to you	- \$600/week on top of your unemployment benefits for any weeks paid in the future - Up to 13 additional weeks of expanded unemployment benefits	Request payment every week or Wait to reopen your claim
<p><b>Are not working due to COVID-19 for one of the following reasons:</b></p> <p><i>** NOTE: If you are being paid leave under FFCRA, you might not be eligible for benefits at the same time. Paid leave is reportable as wages.</i></p> <p><i>Also, not eligible for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance if eligible for regular unemployment benefits or expanded unemployment benefits.</i></p>

** Have primary caregiving responsibility for a child or other person who is unable to attend school or another facility as a result of COVID-19.	<b>39 weeks of expanded benefits</b> (new Pandemic Unemployment Assistance)	<b>\$600/week</b> on top of your regular benefits	<b>Wait to file a Pandemic Unemployment Assistance claim- availability coming soon</b>
