RE: Notice of WARN

Dear Mayor and SD Department of Labor:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act of 1988, which requires affected employers to provide notice to certain government units or officials of a pending mass layoff or permanent closure. This letter serves as official notice that on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, Bishop O'Gorman Catholic Schools anticipates that it will cease educational operations of its Christ The King School (CTK), which has a location at 1801 S. Lake Avenue, Sioux Falls, SD 57105. This closure and termination impacts 31 current employees working at CTK. Pay and benefits will end based on the below schedule¹.

Classified Staff: May 31st
Principal: June 30th
Certified Staff: August 31st (other than Principal)

Termination numbers may be lower should current employees accept a new position within our system. These layoffs are anticipated to be permanent. None of the affected employees are represented by a union and no bumping rights exist.
