**HAZARDOUS OCCUPATION**

It is understood this position does have hazardous occupation(s) in accordance to the U.S. Fair Labor Standards Act. The hazardous occupation(s) for which the exemption applies is (select all that apply):

- On a scaffolding, roof, superstructure, residential building construction or ladder above 6 feet.
- In the operation of power-driven woodworking machines.
- In the operation of power-driven metal forming, punching, or shearing machines.

- In the operation of power-driven paper products and printing machines.
- Excavation operations.
- Power-driven circular, band, chain, or reciprocating saws, guillotine shears, wood chippers, and cutting discs.
