




2023-2024 School Year



Fall 2024







Highlight Stories

Bite of Reality Simulation: Career Ready built a relationship with Explorers Credit Union, who owns a Bite of Reality simulation license. With this license they conduct an interactive activity that shows teens how to make financial decisions and give them a better understanding of the challenges of living on a budget. Students are given a fictional occupation, salary, credit score, spouse and a child, student loan debt, credit card debt, and medical insurance payments.

Premier Virtual Events: Career Ready hosted statewide virtual career fairs each Wednesday during CTE Month (2024) well as a college fair during the Week of Work 2024. These events reached 150+ students, and 25+ schools.

Mitchell Internship Class: In the South-Central region, Mitchell High School, was struggling to place a high school student interested in a financial career. They contacted the CRA to brainstorm ideas, after a few unsuccessful phone calls, the student was able to be placed with the Mitchell Chamber of Commerce. This student has now accepted a long-term position with them and plans to attend college in Mitchell to continue the relationship.

Doland: Given the rural proximity of Doland, they reached out about placing a student for a medical job shadow. This student and teacher worked the Career Ready Advisor to be placed with Avera.
